

DAY 3 POSSESS

“We will face every obstacle and wall with faith in our hearts and the praises of God on our lips.”

SUPPORTING VERSES

Joshua 6:10, 16, 20 (NKJV) ¹⁰Now Joshua had commanded the people, saying, “You shall not shout or make any noise with your voice, nor shall a word proceed out of your mouth, until the day I say to you, ‘Shout!’ Then you shall shout.” ¹⁶And the seventh time it happened, when the priests blew the trumpets, that Joshua said to the people: “Shout, for the Lord has given you the city!” ²⁰So the people shouted when the priests blew the trumpets. And it happened when the people heard the sound of the trumpet, and the people shouted with a great shout, that the wall fell down flat. Then the people went up into the city, every man straight before him, and they took the city.

Jeremiah 32:17 (NKJV) ‘Ah, Lord God! Behold, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and outstretched arm. There is nothing too hard for You.

Jeremiah 32:26-27 (NKJV) Then the word of the Lord came to Jeremiah, saying, “Behold, I am the Lord, the God of all flesh. Is there anything too hard for Me?”

Mark 10:27 (NKJV) But Jesus looked at them and said, “With men it is impossible, but not with God; for with God all things are possible.”

2 Chronicles 20:15b, 17b (NKJV) ¹⁵Thus says the Lord to you: ‘Do not be afraid nor dismayed because of this great multitude, for the battle is not yours, but God’s. ¹⁷...Position yourselves, stand still and see the salvation of the Lord, who is with you...’ Do not fear or be dismayed; tomorrow go out against them, for the Lord is with you.”

2 Corinthians 1:20 (NKJV) For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us.

PRAYER POINTS

- Come into God’s presence, thank God for the blood of Jesus and the gift of His Spirit. Spend time worshipping and praising God.
- Commit yourself and all you have to Him.
- Ask God to enable and empower you to go all out this year - to hold nothing back. Pray God’s will, speak God’s will over yourself, family and friends. Pray with faith and authority. Praise and worship God, lifting up thanksgiving in the areas of impossibility.

DAY 1 PREPARE

“I give myself to God as He gives this New Year to me.”

We start the New Year with surrender and consecration to God as we draw near to pray and seek Him. We put God first. We want to sanctify ourselves in humility and trust as we yield to the Holy Spirit’s work and wholly devote ourselves to the Lord. SUPPORTING VERSES

Joshua 3:5 (AMPC) And Joshua said to the people, Sanctify yourselves [that is, separate yourselves for a special holy purpose], for tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you.

Matthew 6:33 (NKJV) But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

1 Corinthians 1:30 (NKJV) But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God—and righteousness and sanctification and redemption.

Ephesians 5:26 (NKJV) ... that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word.

2 Timothy 2:21 (NKJV) Therefore if anyone cleanses himself from the latter, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work.

Hebrews 10:10 (NKJV) By that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

Philippians 4:13 (AMPC) I have strength for all things in Christ Who empowers me [I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him Who infuses inner strength into me; I am self-sufficient in Christ’s sufficiency].

PRAYER POINTS

- Come into God’s presence through Jesus – He is the door. Thank God for the blood of Jesus and the gift of His Spirit.
- Spend time worshipping and praising God.
- Start the New Year by putting Him first – commit yourself and all the you have to Him.
- Pray and ask God to make you ready, and keep you living ready.
- Ask God to fill you with fresh strength and faith for the new year ahead.

DAY 2 PURSUE

“Be strong and of good courage.”

Let’s take encouragement from God’s words to Joshua. Let’s take steps forward in pursuing the plans and will of God for our lives and loved ones. He will lead us. He will secure every step. Let’s step into the miracle of God’s timing and plans. He will cause every step we take to be a step of advance. We will move forward and make steady gains. We will crossover into the things God has promised. He is with us.

SUPPORTING VERSES

Psalms 37:23-24 (NKJV) The steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord, And He delights in his way. Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down; For the Lord upholds him with His hand.

Psalms 40:1-2 (NKJV) I waited patiently for the Lord; And He inclined to me, And heard my cry. He also brought me up out of a horrible pit, Out of the miry clay, And set my feet upon a rock, And established my steps.

Psalms 32:8 (AMPC) I [the Lord] will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with My eye upon you.

Proverbs 3:6 (AMPC) In all your ways know, recognize, and acknowledge Him, and He will direct and make straight and plain your paths.

Philippians 3:12-14 (NKJV) Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me. Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

PRAYER POINTS

- Come into God’s presence through Jesus – He is the door. Thank God for the blood of Jesus and the gift of His Spirit.
- Spend time worshipping and praising God.
- Start the New Year by putting Him first – commit yourself and all the you have to Him.
